Today we celebrate Deloris Huerta, who worked with Cesar Chavez to form the National Farm Workers Association in the 1960s. Today, at 94 years old, Dolores Huerta still stands as a giant in the fight for Hispanic American labor rights. Huerta runs the Dolores Huerta Foundation and has received several accolades, including an inaugural Eleanor Roosevelt Award for Human Rights in 1998 from President Bill Clinton and the Presidential Medal of Freedom from President Barack Obama in 2012. In 2017, Huerta was the subject of the PBS documentary Dolores about her life and activism (<https://www.biography.com/notable-hispanic-americans>).
